Performance Details:

Run Time: 30 Minutes

Performing Space Requirements:

- Preferred stage dimensions: 40 feet wide and 20 feet deep.
- Wing space: If used, minimum 10 feet must remain clear space exit
- Crossovers: Crossover preferred but not required.





Stage Requirements:

Floor: A sprung wooden floor covered with black or grey Marley, installed and cleaned before rehearsals.

Masking: 5 sets of black legs and borders, black scrim, and white cyclorama.

Temperature: Maintain 70°F on stage, wings, green room, and dressing rooms.

Lighting Requirements:

General: A pre-hung and focused lighting system based on the provided [light plot](#); Robust front lighting for visibility.

Specific Lighting notes for WHITE HOT ROOM to be drafted and modified for the venue / space upon engagement.

Sound Requirements:

Playback:

All music will be provided digitally (file format to be confirmed). QLab or equivalent system preferred.

Sound System:

Full-range speakers and subwoofers with onstage monitors.

Must support a Boss 300 Looping Station for live vocal performance and sound manipulation from performance space.

Crew Requirements:

Load-In and Set-Up:

1 Technical Director
2 Electricians
1 Audio Engineer

Rehearsals and Show:

1 Light Board Operator
1 Sound Engineer
1 stagehand.

Dressing Room Requirements:

Dressing rooms for all performers with mirrors, chairs, tables, and wardrobe racks.

Hospitality:

Bottled water, tea, coffee, and snacks (fruit, granola bars) provided daily. Hot meals available on performance days, with vegetarian and gluten-free options.
